Take kindly the counsel of the years, gracefully surrendering the things of youth.

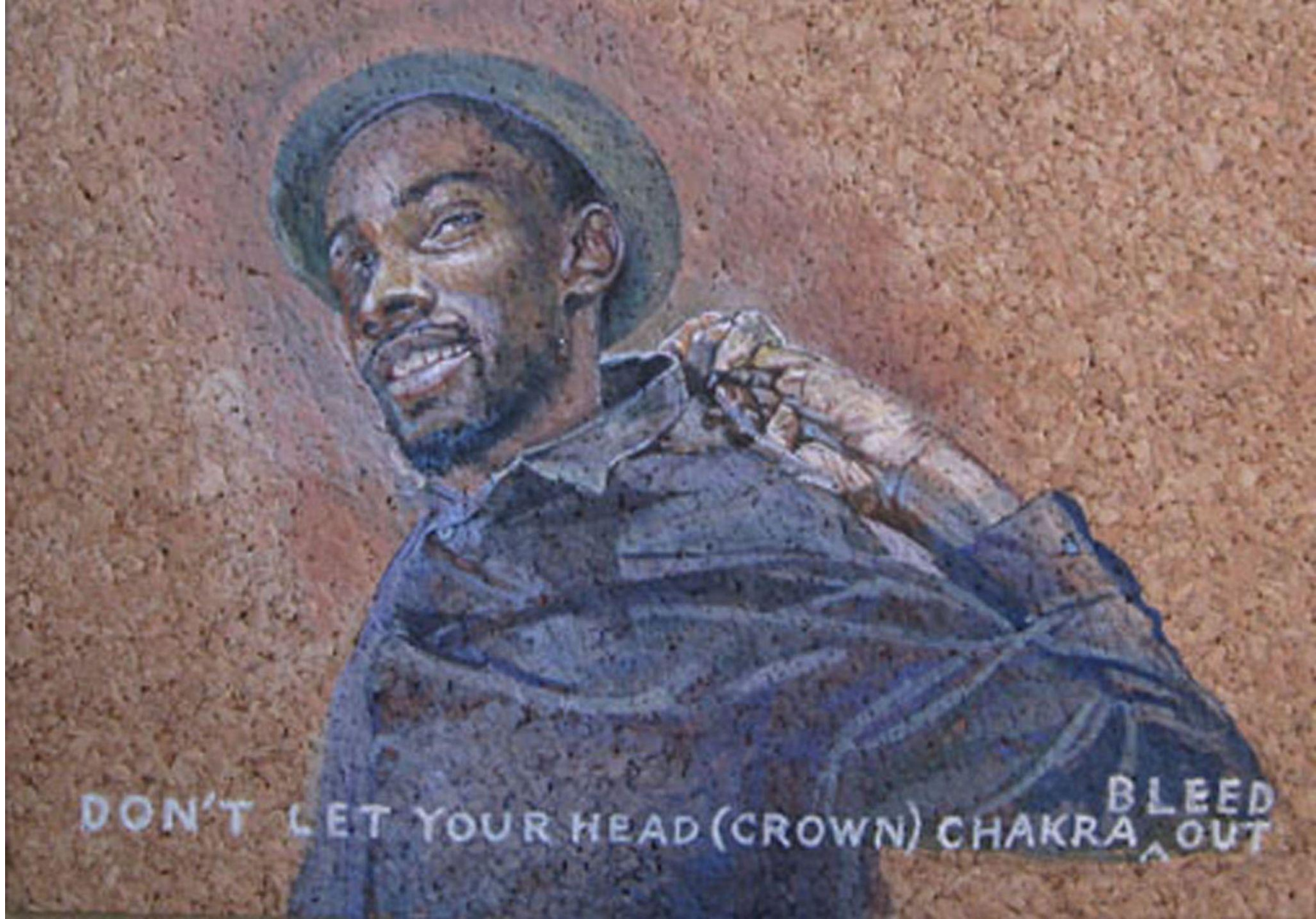
Nurture strength of spirit to shield you in sudden misfortune. But do not dilute strength with casual imagings. Many fears are born of fatigue and loneliness.
